# Philmont Training Center

# Courses offered

The PTC offers twelve (12) weekly training sessions running June through October

## 1. Youth

National Advanced Youth Leadership Experience (Six sessions)

## 2. Adult Courses vary from week to week

- Western Region (usually mid June)
- Southern Region (usually early July)
- Central (usually late July)
- Northern Region (usually early August)



# NAYLE

## National Advanced Youth Leadership Experience

- Six days and nights (Six Sessions)
- Requires successful completion of Introduction to Leadership Skills for Troops or Crews (ILST or ILSC) and National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT).
- Be in top physical condition; a [BSA Annual Health and Medical Record](#) is required.
- Be 14 years of age OR 13 years of age and completed the 8th grade and not yet 21.
- Hold a unit leadership position.

# What's the rest of the family to do?

**PTC runs an active family program for all ages.**

- **Silverados: Adults not participating in training**

- Activities include pottery making, local tours, day hikes, water-water rafting, COPE, shooting sports, horseback riding, etc..
- Sign up for specific activities takes place on Monday morning

- **Mountain Trek: Coed 14-21 yr olds**

- Activities; Backpacking expedition covering 25-40 mi staying at staff camps

- **Broncos: Coed 14-21 yr olds**

- Activities: crafting, local tours, day hikes, water-water rafting, COPE, shooting sports, horseback riding, etc..



# What's the rest of the family to do?

- **Trailblazers: 11-13 yr old boys**
  - Activities include overnighter backpack, local tours, all day hikes, shooting sports, horseback riding, craft center, etc..
- **Mustangs: 11-13 yr old girls**
  - Activities include overnighter, backpack,, shooting sports, horseback riding, craft center, etc..
- **Sidewinders: 10 yr old boys**
  - Activities include overnighter backpack, local tours, all day hike, STEM activities, shooting sports, horseback riding, craft center, etc..



# What's the rest of the family to do?

- **Deputies: 8-9 yr old boys**
  - Activities include local tours, all day hike, Leave No Trace activities, shooting sports, craft center, etc..
- **Ropers: 8-10 yr old girls**
  - Activities include local tours, all day hike, STEM activities, shooting sports, horseback riding, craft center, etc..
- **Bandits: 6-7 yr old coed**
  - Activities include local tours, half day hike, STEM, shooting sports, horseback riding, craft center, etc..
- **Small Fry: 2 months -5 yr old coed**
  - Activities: nature walks, petting zoo, games, pony riding, etc..



# Costs

The 2018 PTC costs were:

1. NAYLE Participant \$420
2. Conference \$550
3. Non-conference (20+) \$390
4. Mountain Trek (ages 14-20) \$430
5. Children (ages 14-20) \$330
6. Children (ages 6-13) \$210
7. Children (ages 0-5) \$105
